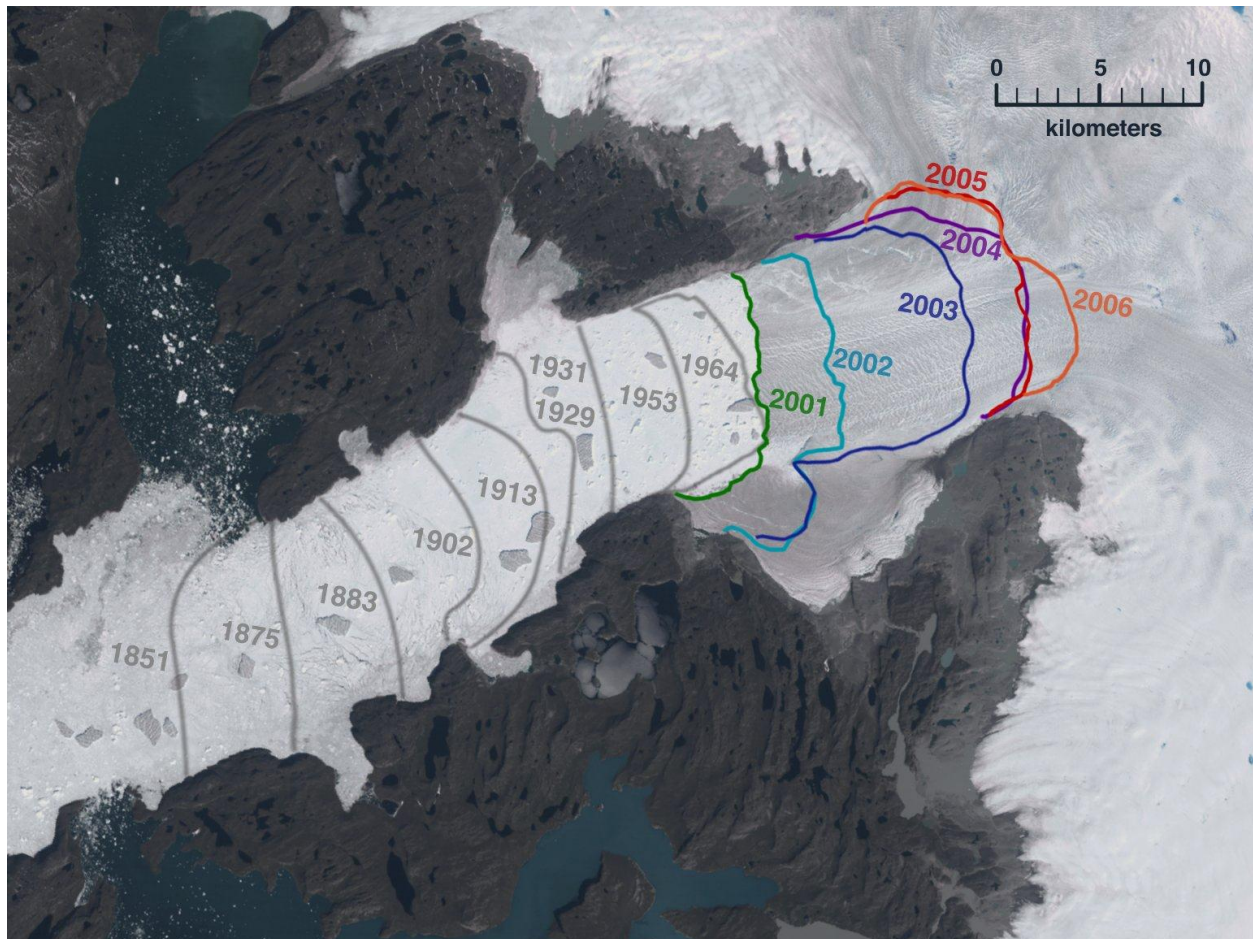

The Jakobshavn Glacier is in western Greenland and drains the central ice sheet. The glacier flows from upper right to lower left.

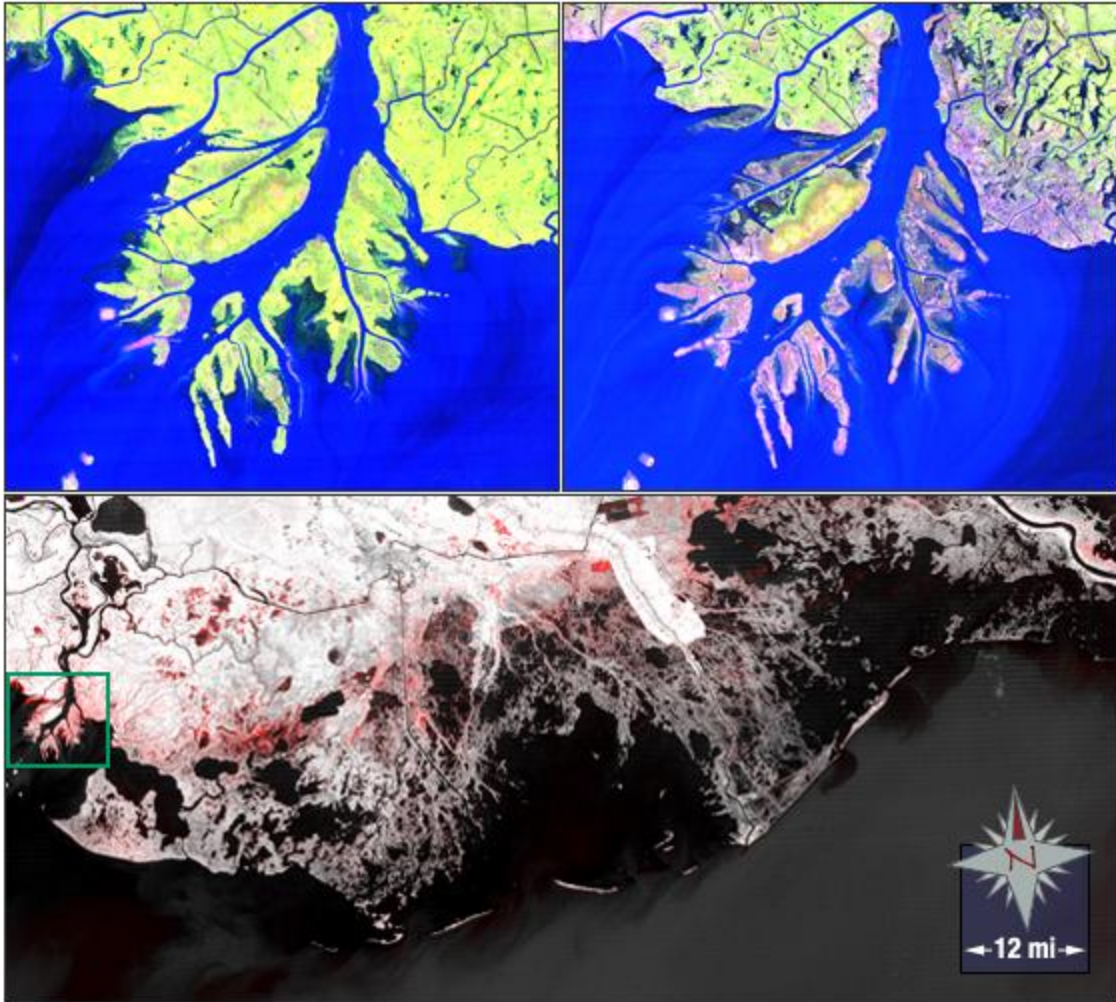

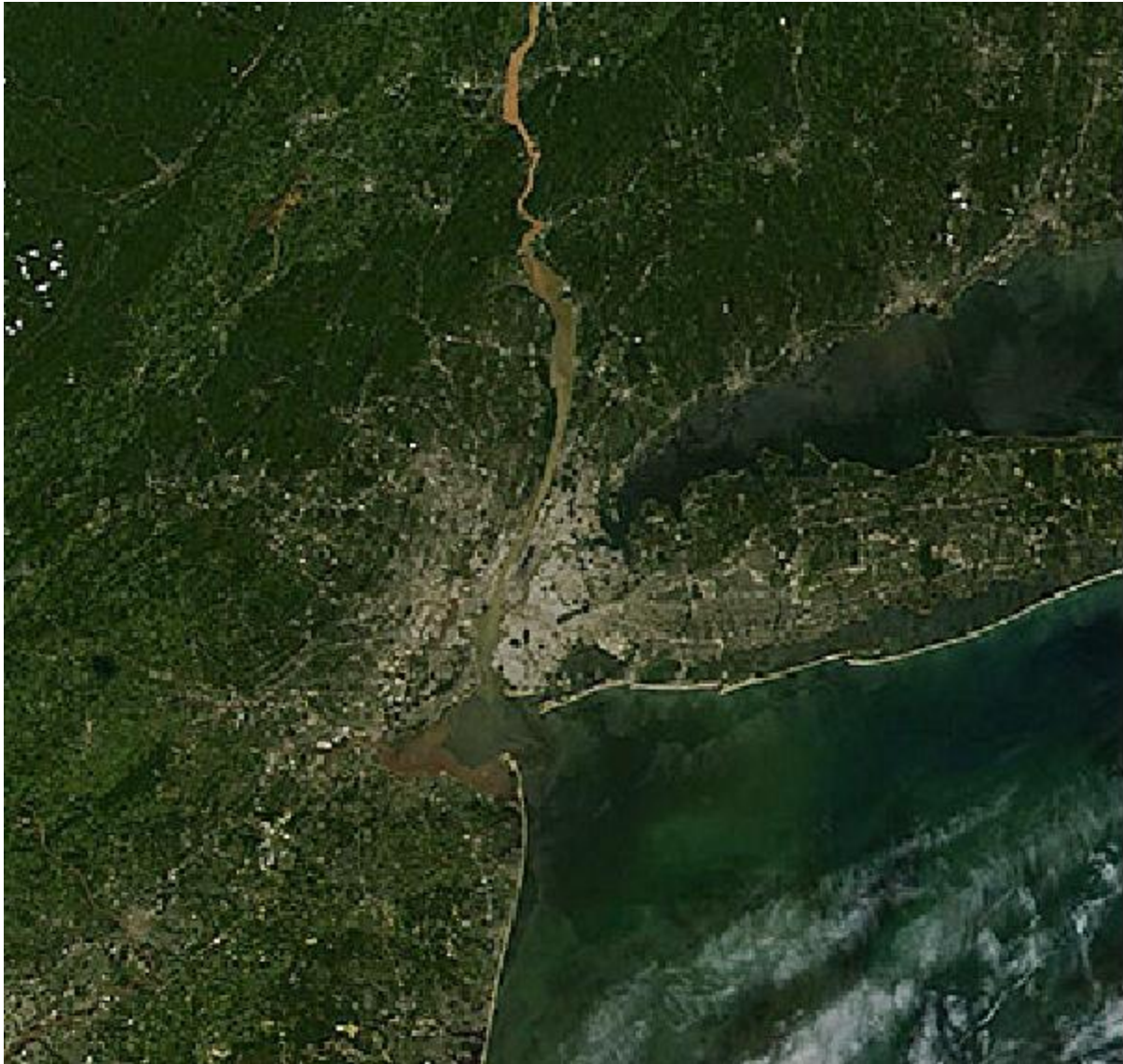
